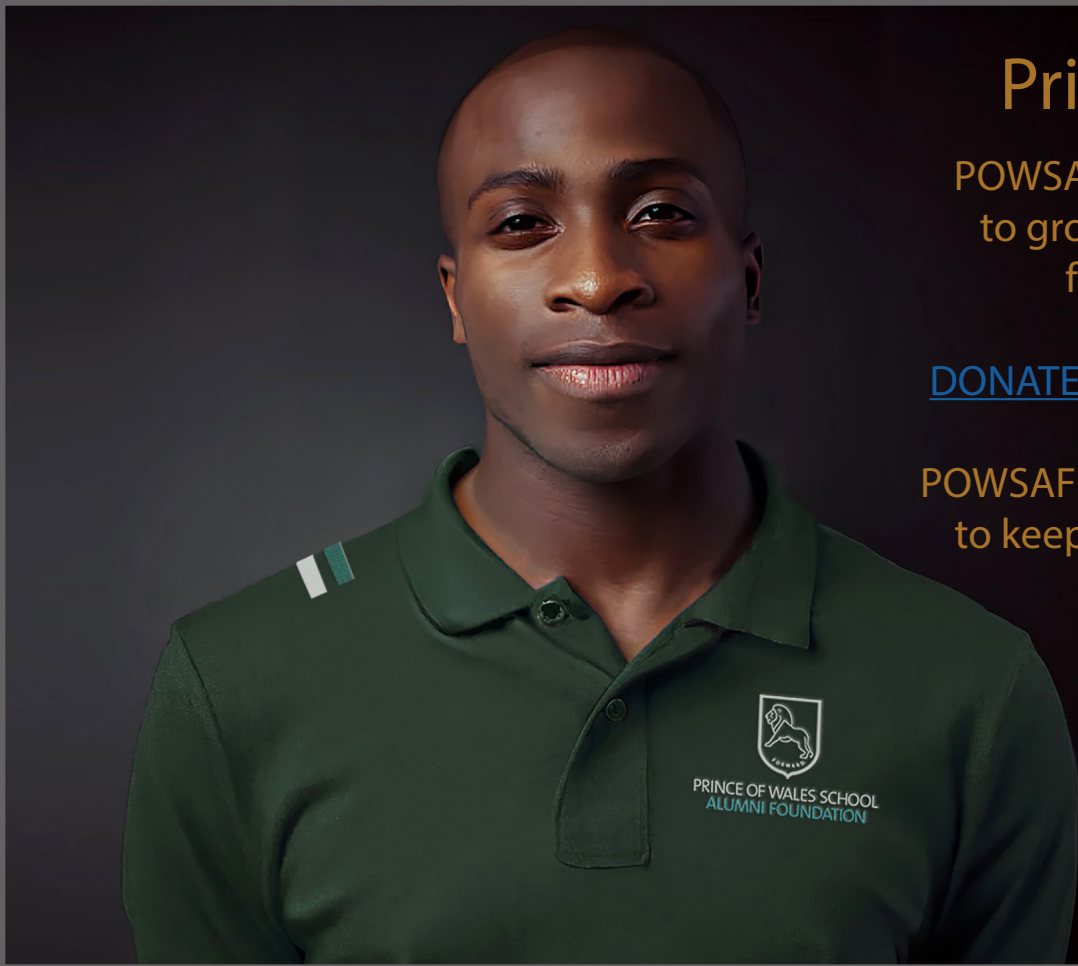

- A 501(c)(3) Endowment Fund based in Georgia, USA, exclusively for the Prince of Wales School.
- Administered by volunteer Executive Officers & managed by Princewalean Trustees who rotate every three years
- Need Alums to build up the fund and also serve in management committees
- Minimum Membership Donation: Alums - \$250; Associations or Corporations - \$2000
- Will fund school projects championed by Alum or Alum Associations

What is POWSAF's Strategy?

1. **Raise Funds** through Alum and Association Donations; Non-Alum Donations; Merchandising; and Grants.
2. **Acknowledge the Funders** through Acknowledgement Letter; Recognition Wall and Welcoming Gift.
3. **Invest the Funds** in the US Capital Markets.
4. **Allocate the Returns from Investments** to Projects that enhance and preserve the school's Educational Attainment.
